- ✓ Please switch off your mobiles while entering the college premises.

RULES FOR EVENTS

1. PAPER PRESENTATION (VISME):

- ✓ Team @ **Two** participants
- ✓ Topics include but not limited to
 - Block Chain
 - Deep Learning
 - Cyber Security
 - Map Reduce
 - Machine Learning
 - Full Stack Engineering
 - Big Data & Data Science in R
 - Holographic Technology
 - Soft Computing
 - Internet of Things (IoT)
- ✓ Submission Guidelines
 - Submissions must include title, author's details, abstract, keywords and full paper should not exceed 6 pages including all tables and figures in the IEEE format
 - Selected participants should bring 2 hard copies of their paper and softcopy of presentation in .ppt format.
 - **7 minutes for presentation and 3 minutes for queries.**
 - The paper in .pdf or .doc format should be mailed to cse@sriramakrishna.ac.in
- ✓ Important Dates:
 - Last date for paper Submission : On or before **Feb 14, 2020**
 - Notification of paper acceptance : **Feb 15, 2020**

2. POSTER DESIGN (POWTOON):

- ✓ Draw the paper according to the theme of the poster and do not contain elements of SARA and pornography
- ✓ Drawing / painting must be on paper of A3 size (297 x 420 mm) or A2 size (420 x 594mm).
- ✓ Shouldn't use any patches, stickers, etc. in the poster
- ✓ The number of color pictures is free
- ✓ The poster is the result of the original that can be accounted for and have not been completed and or published.
- ✓ Participants are not allowed to take the example image or sketch drawings
- ✓ Acceptable tools of drawing / painting include pencil, crayon, water color, oil paint, computer drawing, etc. Photographs, wires, and other 3D objects are not acceptable.
- ✓ The drawing / painting must not include words, national flags, or slogans.
- ✓ The drawing / painting must not represent any particular individual, organization, or brand name and must not depict any religious theme.
- ✓ If the participant is found to have violated the rules will be disqualified and not allowed to continue the competition.

3. SMART SNIFF (DEBUGGING):

- ✓ During contest, no participant is allowed to browse the internet. If any case that participant will be eliminated from the list.
- ✓ Students should participate as a individual member.
- ✓ Basic languages- C ,C++, Java and DBMS.
- ✓ Participants are not allowed to discuss any aspects of the problem with others during challenge.
- ✓ All decision made by the judges are final and are not subject to appeal.
- ✓ The top two participants in the contest will be announced as winners.
